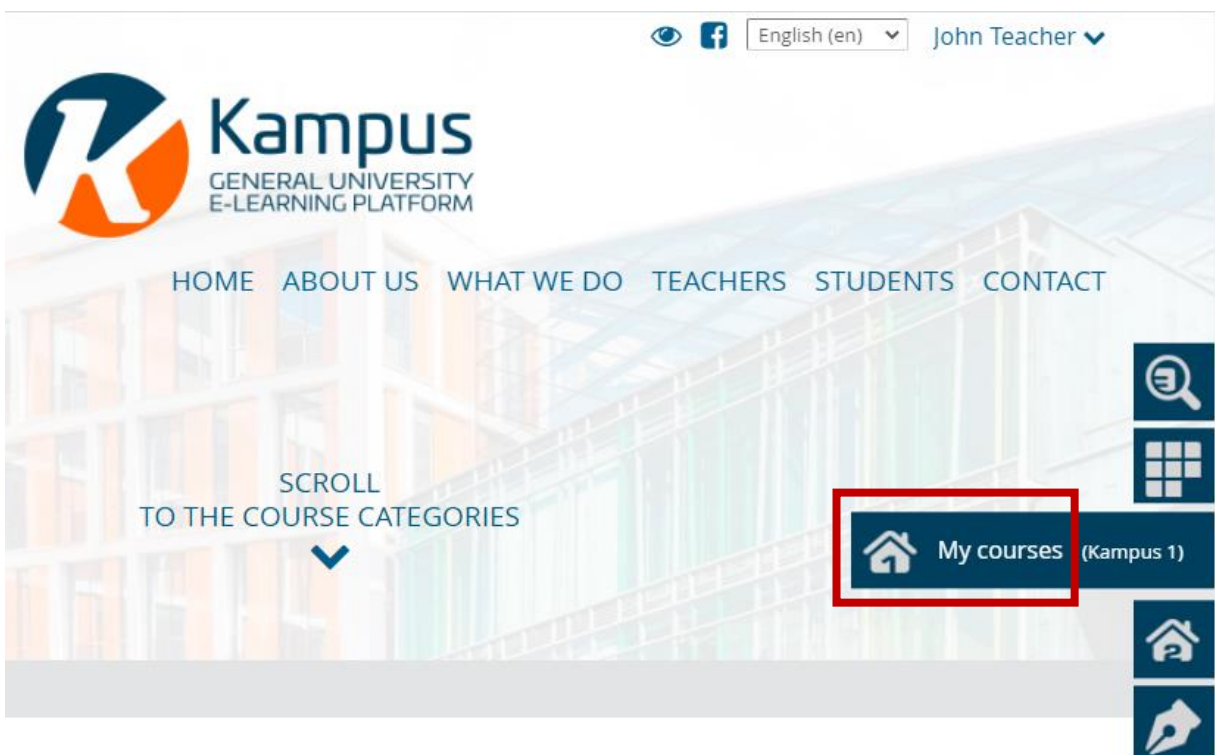
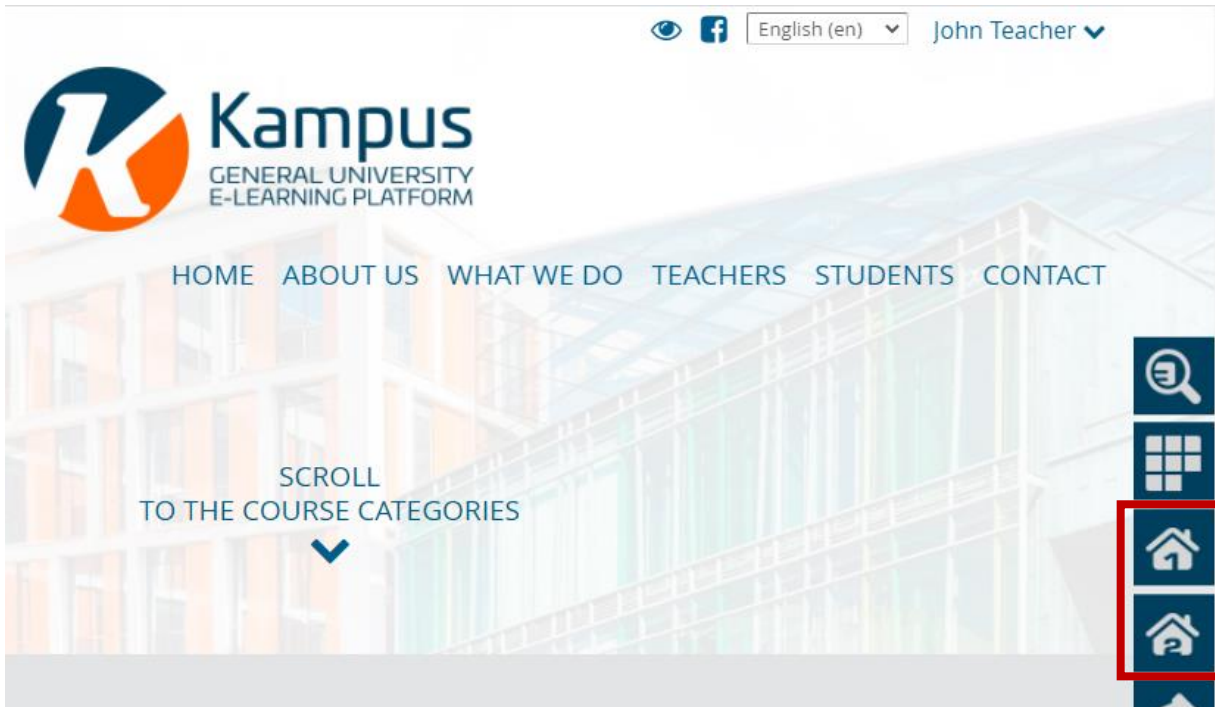



## How to find your course on the Kampus platform

After logging into the Kampus platform click on the icon of a house 1 or 2 at the right edge of the page. Each icon is interactive and slides out when you put the mouse on it.




If you cannot see all your courses when clicking on the house 1 (Kampus 1), click on the house 2 (House 2). Then click on the name of the course you are looking for – you will get redirected to its page.
